Introduction:

The Nine & Dine League is perfect for those who are just starting their golfing journey, who don't have the time to commit to 18-hole play, who may be recovering from an injury, or who haven't previously played in a women's golf league. It will give new players an opportunity to start learning the many rules of golf, how those rules are applied on the course, and to understand how league play operates.

League Format/Guidelines:

- The home course for the Carson Valley Women's Golf Club (CVWGC) is the Carson Valley Golf Course.
- Membership dues in the Club provide players with the opportunity to play in both the 9-hole and 18-hole leagues.
- To determine which tees you should play from, we encourage you to use the **Tee Selection Calculator** located on the front page of the club website: www.cvwgc.com.
- League play is every Wednesday morning starting the first week of April through October. In addition, on the first Tuesday of every month the Nine & Dine League will join the 18-hole league for a theme play day, as well as after play lunch, socializing, and the monthly General Membership Meeting.
- Starting times throughout the season will be:
 - o April: 9:30 a.m.
 - May and June: 8:30 a.m.
 - July and August: 800 a.m.
 - September and October: 9:30 a.m.

Note – The tee time is not a shotgun start but regular successive tee times (e.g. 9:30 am first foursome, 9:37 am second foursome, etc.).

- Players will receive a Golf Genius generated email on Wednesdays for sign-ups the following week. Sign ups for the following Wednesday must be made by no later than 12:00 noon on the Sunday prior to playing the following Wednesday.
- League Chair(s) may elect to set up a fun game for the players. Participation in the game is optional.
- Any player who makes a birdie on a scheduled play day is eligible to fill out a birdie, put it on the Birdie Board, and receive a birdie pin at the end of the season.
- Any player who makes a hole-in-one on a scheduled play day, is eligible to win the hole-in-one bonus and have their name inscribed on the hole-in-one plaque.
- After playing, players have the option to go out to lunch at a local restaurant.
- Any player who makes a hole-in-one on a scheduled play day, is eligible to win the hole-in-one bonus and have their name inscribed on the hole-in-one plaque.

9-Hole League Guidelines

•	Playing <u>only</u> in the Nine & Dine League makes you ineligible for the Eclectic, President's Cup, and Club Championship. See the last two bullet points in the FAQs below for participation qualifications for each of these tournaments.
