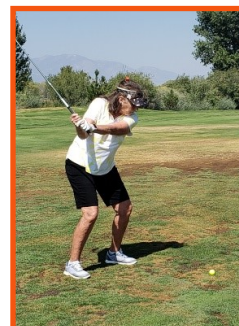

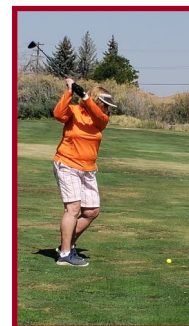

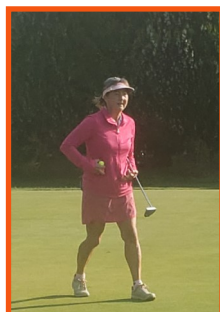

“The cooler weather, pretty leaves on trees and changing colors, and especially Halloween decorations. I always decorate for Halloween!” ~ *Jan Nolan*

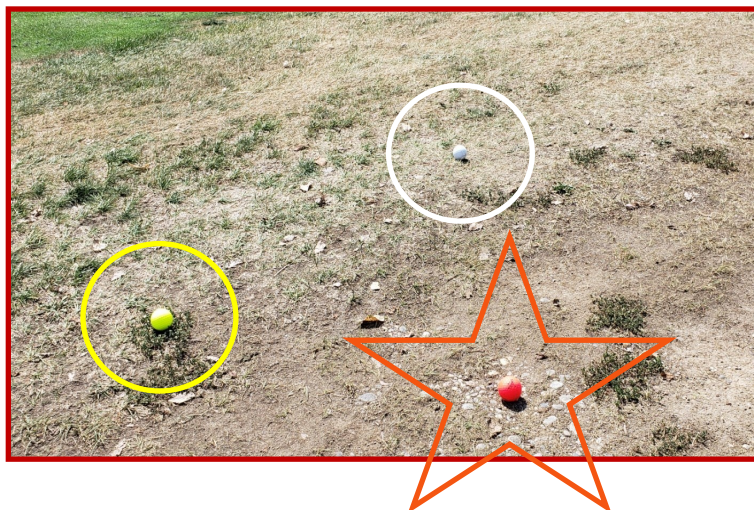
“I like that the weather is better, my garden is almost done, the time change and the fact that it's getting closer to Christmas.” ~ *Mary Milligan*





**D**ear Patti, Clarification was needed when three of our four-some's tee shots ended up in the "waste-land" off the right of Hole #2 fairway. Knowing that "**bare**" dirt **in the fairway** qualifies for free relief as ground-under-repair, we were wondering which of these three lies **in the rough** qualify for free relief?

Hola 3 Amigos,

Being rough in the "wasteland", our Local Course Rules deem only the **orange** ball gets relief for being on rocks. No relief is given for the yellow ball tee'd up on a patch of grass or for the white ball on bare ground. Only bare ground/dirt **IN THE FAIRWAY** (not the "wasteland") is considered "ground under repair" and relief without penalty is allowed. Remember, it's bare ground/dirt **NOT** dead brown grass that gets you relief!

## On Par With Dan



### What to Think About When You're Playing Golf

**I**t can be overwhelming trying to play golf with all the swing thoughts that can fill your head. While working on your game, it is easy to be focused on 100 things all at once and forget that you still need to swing the club.

What I recommend is a simple swing thought that is just there to remind you of your tempo in the swing. It is not always best to be thinking of the little things like which way your hands are moving or to keep your head still because these thoughts can make you tight and not release the club. A simple repeatable thought like saying "one and two," or "green, blue" can quiet down the mind. Remember to swing the club and not try to hit the ball for the most effective golf shots.
