### **Dear Patti** Patti Parker's Monthly Rules Advice Column

Dear Patti, I was on the tee, took my swing, and knocked the ball off the tee. What are my options? Missed and Miffed

Dear Missed and Miffed, if the ball is still within the "Tee Box" you may re-tee the ball anywhere in the "Tee Box" (teeing area) and hit your second stroke. You have two other options as well. You can move your ball anywhere within the teeing area or you can play your ball as it lies to take your second shot.

USGA Rule 6.2b defines the "Tee Box" as two-club lengths back from and perpendicular to the front line of the tee markers (a two-club length deep rectangle). To see the full rule and teeing area designation, click on this link: **USGA Rule 6.2**
