




Dear Patti Patti Parker's Monthly Rules Advice Column

Dear Patti, I hit my ball into the water (so sad!). The water was parallel to and alongside the direction of my play. What are my options to get myself out of water trouble?

Signed, Miss Directed

Dear Miss Directed, well lucky you, you have <u>three</u> options to get yourself out of water trouble, although each one has a one-stroke penalty: (1) Stroke and distance relief based on where the previous stroke was played. (2) Back on the line relief, but that will probably keep you within the penalty area. (3) Lateral relief (red penalty only). The reference point (black **X** on picture to the right) is where the ball entered the penalty. Lateral relief is two club lengths from where the ball entered the penalty area/water. If you can, it's best to avoid the water!
