It's Time to Nominate and Vote!

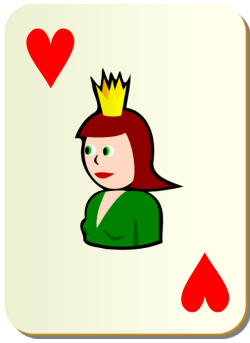

Dear Patti, I was having a great round and then the next thing I know, I'm in a sand trap. What are my options? Signed, "Sandy Beach"

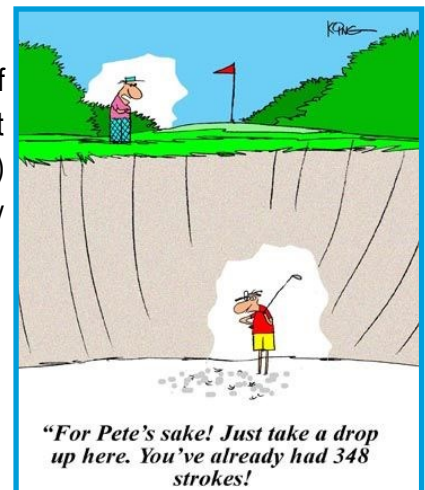
Dear Sandy Beach, this is surely a test of your ability to play nice in the sand. If you consider your ball playable, then for no penalty strokes, go ahead and hit your ball out of the sand. However, if you decide your ball is unplayable, you have four (yes, FOUR) options to consider, and it is up to you to decide which option is best for your sandy situation.

Option #1: For a 1-stroke penalty, you may take stroke and distance.

Option #2: For a 1-stroke penalty you may take back-on-the line relief in the bunker.

Option #3: For a 1-stroke penalty you may take lateral relief in the bunker.

Option #4: For a 2-stroke penalty you may take back-on-the line relief outside the bunker.

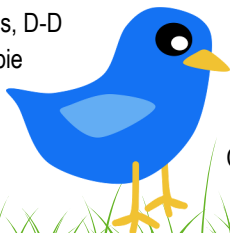

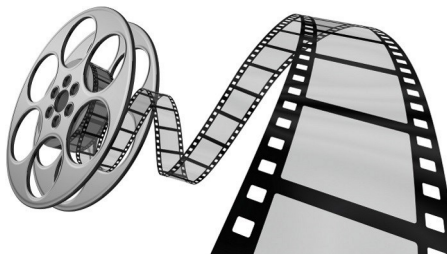
