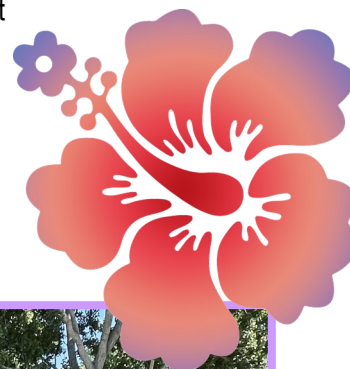

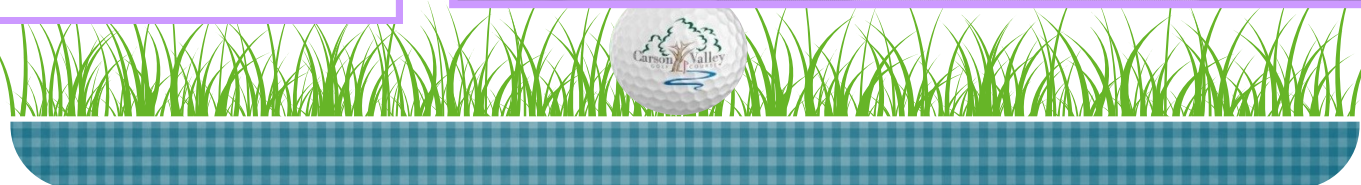
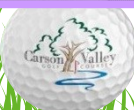

Patti Parker's Monthly Rules Advice Column



Dear Patti,
My ball landed in a brown area on the fairway. What are my options?

Signed, Stuck in the not so fair fairway

Our local club rule found on your clipboard states "*Bare dirt/ground in the **fairway** qualifies for Free Relief*" when considered as ground-under-repair. Your group must decide if the fairway is fair or not. Dead or dry grass does **not** qualify as bare dirt nor would a divot. Patches of many divots will often look as bare dirt but those divots are **not** considered ground-under-repair and your ball must be played as it lies.

The second rule clarifies that "*Bare dirt/ground in the **rough** of the general area one must play their ball as it lies*" Best to stay out of what is called Waste-Area. However IF it is a consensus of the group that your club head or swing is likely to come into contact with rocks or stones then **one club length of free relief is allowed**. It goes without saying, it's best to keep it in the fairway!

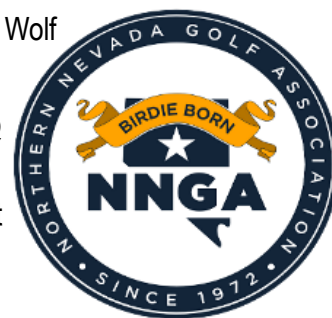

Where Can I Find Out How I Did on Tuesday?

Good question! It takes about a week for results to be posted on Golf Genius, but that's where you can find out how you placed in the previous Tuesday's play. Sign in on [GOLF GENIUS](#). Do not put in a password, use GGID **CVWC23**. On the top bar, click on **RESULTS**. From the drop-down menu, select

the week's results you want to look at. For the gross winner (we payout only one gross winner each week), click on **GROSS**. For the net winners, click on **NET** and scroll down through the different flights until you find your name. If you've won money for that week, you'll see that next to your name.

How Much Money Have I Won?

Another good question! If you want to find out how much money you've won year-to-date in our weekly tournament play, it's oh-so-easy, and here's how you find out just how much (if any) money you have on account:

Sign in on [GOLF GENIUS](#) as instructed above. On the top bar, click on **PLAYER STATISTICS**. Scroll down to find your name; click on your name. At the top of your page, you will see your player statistics including how much you've won year-to-date.

As a reminder, all your winnings can only be spent at the Pro Shop and Clubhouse for purchasing items and/or food, but cannot be used to pay for green fees.
