General Meeting Minutes May 3, 2022

Kelly King called the General Membership Meeting to order at 1:52 p.m. at Carson Valley Golf Clubhouse.

Treasurer's Report (Kathy Belvel in Margaret Fay's absence)

- We have \$5,933.36 in our checking account. This amount includes our GHIN fees that we still need to pay, and we are waiting for the invoice.
- We have \$1,616.65 in our Savings Account. This money is generally used for Scholarships and the Junior Golf Club.
- Our 2022 budget was calculated based on 50 members and we have 52 members this year.
- Dan D'Angelo has identified three Junior Golfers the Club will be sponsoring for the summer clinic. Once they accept the scholarships Dan is going to put together a luncheon later in the year inviting the recipients. He suggested we make big checks to hand to them at that time. Judy and Kelly will work on this.
- Dan announced that CVGC will be starting the only PGA Junior League in the Carson Valley for kids ages 7 through 13. The deadline to sign up is this Sunday, May 8th. If you know someone who would be a candidate, please have them contact CVGC.

President's Report (Kelly King)

- Pace of Play: A big thank you to everyone for picking up their pace of play today. All foursomes came in just about the same time, which is excellent.
- Reminder, the first **Golf Clinic** (Driving) is Tuesday, May 17th at 7:30 a.m. and will run 45-minutes. We need a minimum of 10 sign-ups (maximum of 12) for the clinic. We are short sign-ups so if you are interested contact the Pro Shop as soon as possible to sign up.
- Open chair positions: HSTP Captain and By-Laws & House Rules Chair. Judy found out after the meeting that we also need a Sunshine Chair. The Sunshine Chair is responsible for sending out cards to members for birthdays, illnesses/surgeries/etc. Please let a Board member know if you are interested in joining the Team and taking on one of these positions.

- Just a reminder, we are paying KP on three holes each week, and as Dan stated before we started playing today, if your ball is FURTHER away than the last measured length on the measuring tool, please do not put your name down!
- The Board also reversed a previous decision and will now be paying for KPs and Chip-ins on team-play days. However, we will not be recording or recognizing birdies or eagles.
- Combo Tees: There was concern raised about the combo tees that
 people do not like playing from them. There was a lot of discussion
 about the combo tees which are only being used on days where we
 have team-play games. There was concern about some people not
 hitting their tee shots long enough to make it to the fairway. This is a
 topic that the Board will continue to discuss and get more input on
 throughout the season.
- Our June theme is "Life's A Beach".
 - The General Meeting has been changed to June 14th to accommodate Women's Golf Day on June 7th.
 - There will be a longest drive competition on Hole #10 with 1st and 2nd places.
 - The lunch will be Steve's famous Hawaiian Burger for \$10.00. An email will be sent out 1-1/2 weeks in advance for RSVPs.
- There was a question about picking up your ball and how you score the hole. Kathy Belvel explained that once you reach the max number of strokes (Double Bogey + POPS. Example: On a Hole #6, a Par 5, double bogey is 7. I have two POPs; therefore, my max stroke or "net double bogey" would be 9. If I decide to pick up at this point, I would estimate the number of additional strokes I would have to make in order to hole-out, possibly 3 more strokes. I would then add the three strokes to the nine and record a score of 12 on my scorecard.
- Judy Brooke (Vice President) talked about Women's Golf Day (WGD) on Tuesday June 7th. WGD is a nationwide event where women from all ages and levels are encouraged to participate and bring in new golfers. CVGC is hosting an event that will include free golf clinics and a free lunch.  - The public will join our Club for play that day (4-person scramble).
 - Sign up in Golf Genius if you plan on playing in the scramble.

- Donna Sugden (Tournament Chair) reviewed the following three Club policies with members:
 - Unless you receive permission from a golfer, please do not provide unsolicited help/teaching/training. If a golfer says they are open to your input, then you may proceed.
 - As previously communicated to everyone, you must play with whomever the computer assigns you. You may not elect to <u>not</u> play with someone.
 - If you are not signed up in Golf Genius to play, but show up to play, no harm/no foul! You are welcome to play, pay the \$6.00 prize fund fee, and join in both KP and chip-in side bets. However, you do forfeit being eligible for any prize fund winnings.
- 50/50 Raffle (DD Woodruff, Chair)
 - We collected a total of \$123.00.
 - Gail Ellingwood was the winner taking home \$61.00 and \$62.00 will go into the Scholarship Fund.
